Top 36 players according to ringer percentage will be entered in "A" class, balance will fall into "B" and "C" Class.

"A" Class wil consist of 3 groups of 12, each group to play round robin (11 games) each game to be determined by pitching (50) shoes, ringers, and points to count.

Top 4 players in each group will move into Championship flight on a "cancellation and knockout" basis. After first game the six winners will move into semi-finals which will consist of 3 players, highest percentage of the 3 players will receive a bye into the final. Prizes are as follows:
